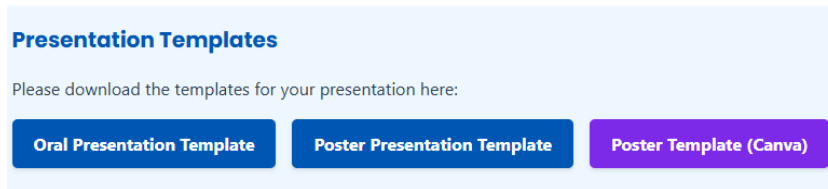


Guidelines for Poster Presentation

1. Use the poster presentation template as provided from our link <https://interconf.nur.psu.ac.th/guideline/>



2. Prepare your poster with the following dimensions: 95 cm (W) x 140 cm (H), in **portrait** orientation.
3. Please print this poster **on paper or vinyl** and bring it to the venue.
4. Please mount your poster on the board following assigned poster board number with presenter name by **May 27, 2026 at 8:30 AM to 1:00 PM**. The board number assigned to each presenter will be listed in the poster presentation schedule from our conference website (posted on April 27, 2026) and displayed at the registration desk on the day of the event.
5. Presenters have the flexibility to design the font styles and sizes appropriate for the presentation.
6. The poster includes the following sections:
 - Title
 - Author name
 - Institution name
 - Background and keywords
 - Purpose
 - Methods
 - Results/Findings
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - Acknowledgements
 - References
7. Please check your assigned poster board number in advance and arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the presentation for registration and preparation.
8. The total time allocated for each presentation is 7 minutes, consisting of
 - o 5 minutes for presentation
 - o 2 minutes for Q&A

Note: All presenters will receive certificates for their poster presentations after the session. The best poster presentation in each theme will be announced at the closing session of the conference on 29 May 2026.

Guideline for poster presentation for presenters

Opening & Introduction

- Introduce yourself: introduce yourself and your topic with one compelling sentence that is interesting in audience.

Main Presentation

- **Background:** What problem did you study/gap?
- **Methods:** How did you investigate it/approach?
- **Results:** What did you find/findings?
- **Conclusion:** What does this mean/main takeaway?

Questions & Closing

- Answer 1-2 questions briefly

Note: After all presentation: Give poster certificate to presenter and take a photo together.
